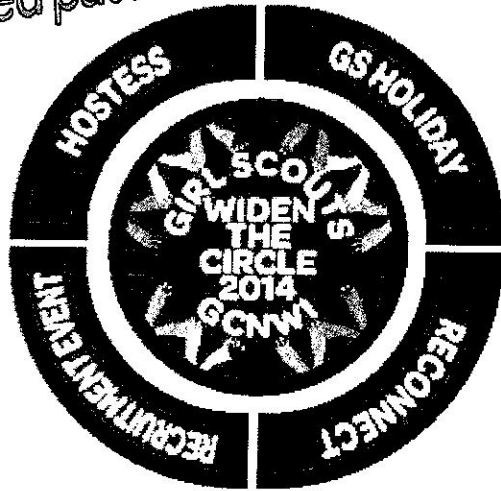

## Widen the Circle

### **Community Builder Activities – Complete at least 2 of the following:**

- **Public Display**  
Create a public Girl Scout display, poster board, or other visual element, and place it in a prominent public place (e.g. library, school, place of worship, fair, or community building). The display must be visible for at least two days.
- **Newspaper Submission**  
Prepare a photo and brief story about an activity, event, community service project, or award in which you or your troop has participated. Submit your article and photo to a local newspaper and Girl Scout Council. If your local newspaper would prefer to attend your event and generate their own photos and story, then invite them in advance!
- **Uniformed Event**  
Participate in a public event such as a parade, flag ceremony or community celebration in Girl Scout uniform.
- **Hostess\***  
Serve as a hostess for an event held by another organization (e.g. PTA, local women's club, place of worship, town meeting, etc.) while in Girl Scout uniform or apparel. Send a photo and story to your Girl Scout Council!
- **Girl Scout Celebration\***  
Host a Girl Scout celebration such as Founder's Day (Juliette Gordon Low's birthday), Thinking Day, Girl Scout Week/Birthday or Leader Appreciation Day and encourage others to join the fun by inviting your community to attend. Advertise your event on a community
