- **Recruitment Event \***

- **Girl Scout Table**

Set up and run a Girl Scout table at an open house, registration event, conference night, school event, etc.

- **Reconnect with Alumnae \***

Were any of your teachers, coaches, family members or friends at church ever Girl Scouts? Find out if anyone you know is a Girl Scout alumna and re-register her. Encourage adult alumnae to volunteer in their communities.

- **Add a Girl**

Add a girl. Register a new girl to your troop.

- **Register Adults**

Register one adult for every girl in the troop. Don't forget to ask your teachers!

- **Share a Meeting**

Do you know a new troop at your school or in your community that is eager to get started? How about some girls and parents who want to join the fun? Invite them to your next meeting and show them how this Girl Scout thing is done.

- **Create Your Own**
